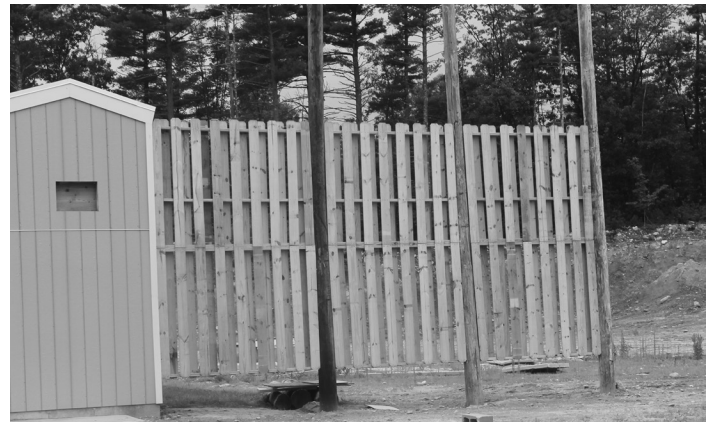

## Young Adult Pheasant Hunt

Norco Sportsman's Club, Inc. has conducted the Division of Fisheries and Wildlife's Young Adult Pheasant Hunt since 2005 on our Princeton grounds. (for more info goto: [mass.gov/eea/agencies/dfg/dfw/education-events/young-adult-pheasant-hunt.html](http://mass.gov/eea/agencies/dfg/dfw/education-events/young-adult-pheasant-hunt.html)) The program is open to all young women and men between ages 12-17 who have successfully completed the Massachusetts Basic Hunter Education Program. A Firearms Identification Card (FID) and hunting license are required for all young adults between the ages of 15 to 17. Young adults 12 to 14 years of age do not need a license or FID card. The program is offered at no charge to the youth. The ammunition and targets are paid for by Norco. The Division of Fisheries and Wildlife supplies the pheasants. We have shotguns available to use if you do not have one.
