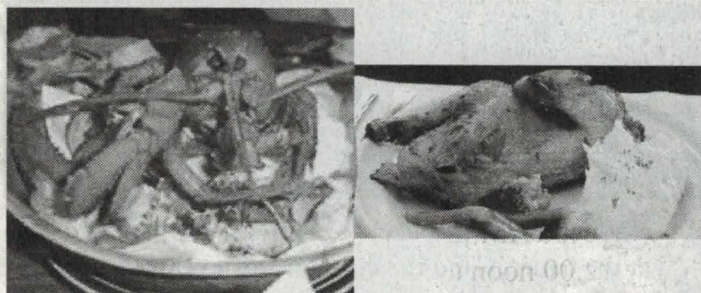

Overview Information for Norco Qualifier Round:

Youth trap shoot program open to members and non-members between the ages of 12 and 17 years of age (age 18 cutoff is July 23rd 1999)

No fee to enter the program, though signed entry forms required; download form from web or pickup at Norco Trap House

Youth will shoot up to 3 rounds (25 clays per round, singles – 1 shot per clay); best score submitted

Ties among the top 3 shooters will be broken with run-off round(s)

Ammo rounds at the expense of the shooter

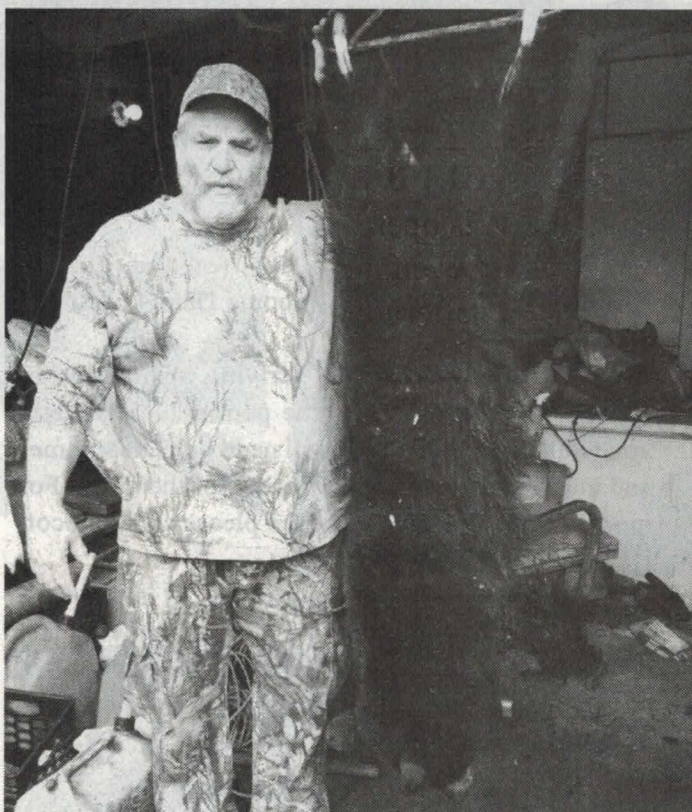

First Aid/CPR/AED and Gunshot Wound Management Training Class

Offered at Norco September 9th, 2017

Life Saving Safety Training by certified trainers for anyone who enjoys shooting and hunting, is a firearm or hunting instructor, is a range/safety officer, newly trained youth hunters, and everyday life situations indoors or outdoors at home, work, or play.

Be familiar and learn how to use a gunshot wound (GSW) trauma kit with different types of tourniquets and different types of blood clotting bandages; when to use and not use a tourniquet; what type of bandage for location of a wound. Be familiar and learn how to use a AED (Automated External Defibrillator), administer First Aid, and perform CPR
