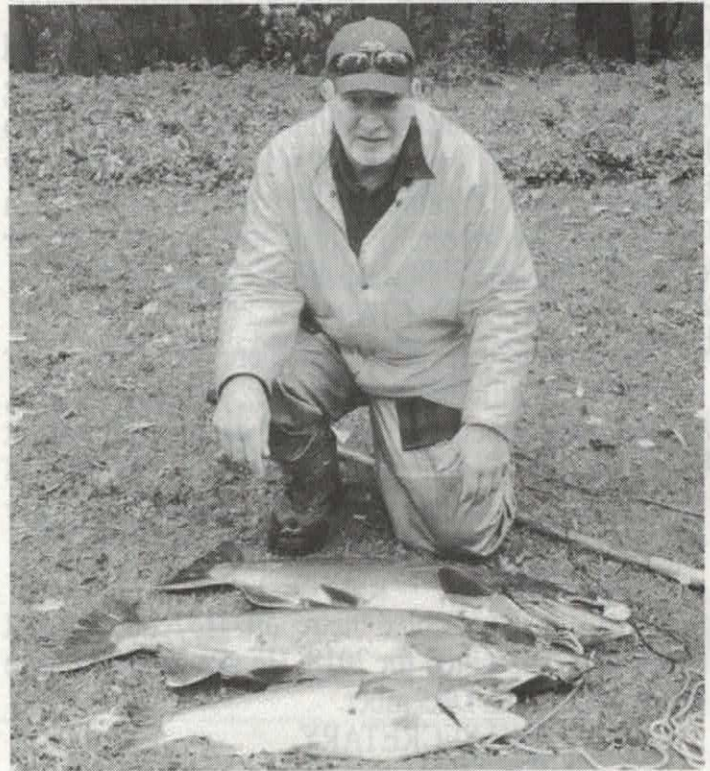

Heartsaver® First Aid CPR AED teaches critical skills for respond to and manage of an emergency, until emergency medical services arrives. Skills include first aid; choking relief and sudden cardiac arrest for adults and children.

First Aid topics cardiac, respiratory, overdose, bleeding, temperature extremes, and burns.

This course is for anyone with limited or no medical training. Course completion card in CPR/AED and GSW Management Certificate included.

Gunshot Wound Management training includes how to address severe bleeds, methods to control bleeding, and manage shock, and tourniquet application practical.
