See picture in this months issue and the large smile on that hunters face! Norco will be hosting Fall Pheasant Hunting Program this year, starting with shotgun training at the trap range in August. June 12th Steakout will not happen. However June 12th Family Fun Day will happen. This is a new program, low key, no advance tickets to purchase. Activities are geared to try something new, regardless of what you already do, with a bias to youth. Archery range will have compound bows and crossbows to try – shoot out a balloon or a 3D target, rifle/pistol range will have an assortment of calibers to try, trap & skeet range will have shotguns and ammo to try a round of 5 clays, in one of our fields there will be a few bushcraft demonstrations to make fires and emergency shelters. Non-members will be asked to sign a waiver if they choose to handle bows or firearms. While this is all going on, pick and choose the activity as you may, there will be food to order/buy dogs, burgers, venison sausage and seating on the club patio. At the end of the day, Norco will hold two drawings Cabela Gift Card drawing and its Archery Target drawing. Tickets can be bought on the same day. Though all the activities are for free, due to generous donations of ammo, loan of firearms and archery gear, donations are welcome. Watch the state COVID guidelines...life is getting back to normal, come out and kickoff your summer. Though fishing will be possible in the pond, it may be fished out, we may have fishing skills going on teaching how to tie knots, work a lure. The Gift Card Raffle is for \$600, \$300, and \$100 – 5 tickets for \$20; 1 ticket for \$5. Archery tickets are \$1 each, 4butts and 1 case to be raffled.

If you have been missing the monthly members meetings, you are not earning those easy volunteer work credit hours. Several quick updates what is going on at the club: Trap and skeet continue to have good turnout- open 3 days a week. Looking for ammo, look over online retailer midwayusa.com – popular range ammo for trap, skeet, pistol, and rifle – at market prices. Club has pheasants on order for the fall program. Another 18-wheeler of clays is on the way. Club has restored field behind pistol range for pheasant hunting. The club garage will have a new roof, siding, and 2nd garage door. Clubhouse 2nd floor was refinished. Fishing derby went well. Club finances are stable with the endowment fund, range donations, fundraisers and raffles underway. Archery range refreshed the range butts, staged a raffle, and will resume 15 3D stations with additional targets being acquired. Youth Turkey hunter ed was held. Though several indoor programs and bar have been effected by COVID – hats off to the club leadership, range chairs, and volunteers to keep the club at 100% of our traditional outdoor programs.
