- 1. By becoming a member, you have agreed to follow all the club policies for ranges, for membership and volunteerism, and its bylaws. You will have read the rifle and pistol range policies and signed a waiver form.
- 2. You have been provided a key to the club gate, which enables you to enter and leave the club main entrance. This same key also opens the men's room outside door of the Norco Clubhouse. This same key also opens the fish pond shed where there are first aid supplies close to the rifle and pistol range. This same key also opens a small tool and supply box at the rifle range, to assist shooters with self-maintenance of the rifle and pistol range along with supplies found in the standing plastic sheds at the rifle range. You've paid \$10 deposit on a key, the deposit is returned when you no longer want to be a member and return the key.
- 3. First aid and medical emergency signs are posted at the ranges. Read them to become familiar with protocol. First aid supplies and devices are located as follows:
 - a. Fish Pond shed has first aid bandages and an IFAK (tourniquet and blood clot gauze). Your key opens this shed. Closest kits and supplies to rifle and pistol range
 - b. Trap House has first aid band aids and an IFAK. Trap House open only these days and hours: Monday and Thursday 6PM-9PM; Saturday 1PM to 4PM
 - c. Clubhouse Men's Room has AED, automated external defibrillator, and IFAK
 - d. Clubhouse has various first aid kits behind the bar, by the pool table, and in the 2nd floor kitchen. Clubhouse hours are Thursday 6PM 12Midnight
