Current state-wide effort is for you to contact by phone/email/letter your MA Senate legislator to state your objections; additionally, your town/city local police chief, since LEO is effected with new burdens of enforcement, administration, and no carve-outs. Norco has HD4420 lawn signs at the bar for pickup; donations appreciated

but not required. The House did pass H4135 (former versions HD4420/4607). Reminder to get out and vote for your Central MA Senator of choice on November 7th. The republican and democrat candidates both voted against H4135, supporting our 2A rights and law-abiding firearm owners.
