March 16, 2024

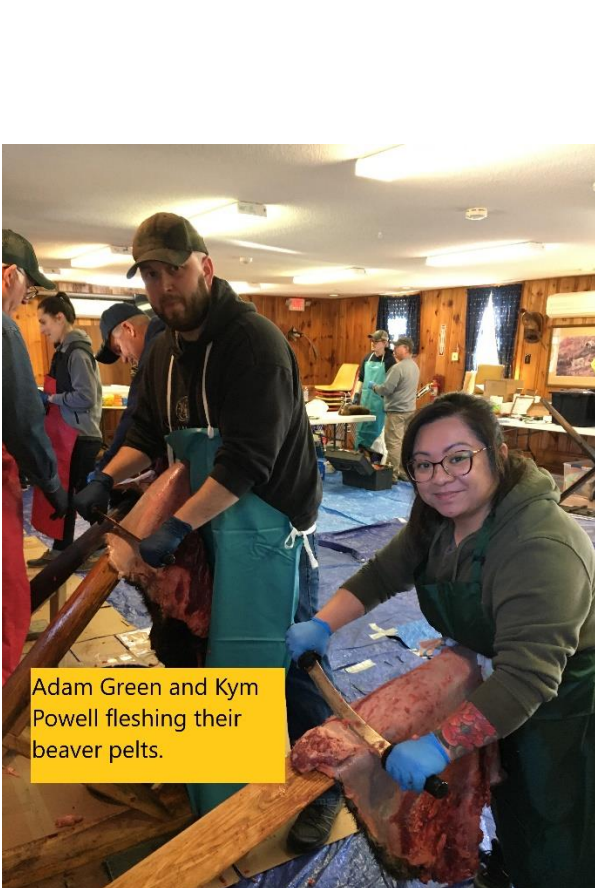
