



**Norco Sportsman’s Club, Release, Waiver, Indemnification,  
Hold Harmless and Assumption of Risk Agreement**

WHEREAS, in consideration of being permitted to shoot firearms and archery at Norco Sportsmen’s Club and for use of its premises, and for other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged, Undersigned agrees to the following:

Undersigned agrees to indemnify, hold harmless and defend Norco Sportsmen’s Club, from any and all fault, liabilities, cost, expenses, claims, demands or lawsuits arising out of, related too or connected with: Undersigned’s presence at and/or participation in the discharge of guns/archery by Undersigned; Undersigned’s presence on or use of the range, buildings, land and premises (“Premises”); and, any and all acts or omissions of Undersigned.

Undersigned furthermore waives for themselves and for their executors, personal representatives, administrators, assignees, heirs and next of kin, any and all rights and claims for damages, losses, demands and any other actions or claims whatsoever, which he/she may have or which may arise against Norco Sportsmen’s Club (including but not limited to the death of Undersigned and/or any and all injuries, damages or illnesses suffered by Undersigned or Undersigned’s property, which may, in any way whatsoever, arise out of, be related to or be connected with: the discharge of firearms; archery, the Premises, including any latent defect in the Premises; Undersigned’s presence on or use of said Premises; Undersigned’s property; and, the discharge of guns and use of bow and arrows. Norco Sportsmen’s Club shall not be liable for, and Undersigned, on behalf of themselves and on behalf of their executors, personal representatives, administrators, assignees, heirs and next of kin, hereby expressly releases the Norco Sportsmen’s Club from any and all such claims and liabilities.

Undersigned herby expressly assumes the risk of taking part in the discharge of firearms/archery and taking part in the activities on the Premises, which include, but are not limited to, the use of guns/bows, the discharge of guns and the firing of live ammunition and or arrows.

Undersigned hereby acknowledges and agrees that Undersigned has read this instrument and understands its terms and is executing this instrument voluntarily. Undersigned furthermore hereby acknowledges and agrees that he/she has read, understands and will at all times abide by all range rules and procedures and any other rules and procedures stated by the Norco Sportsmen’s Club.

Undersigned expressly agrees that this instrument is intended to be as broad and inclusive as permitted by law, and that if any provision of this instrument is held invalid or otherwise unenforceable, the enforceability of the remaining provisions shall not be impaired thereby. No remedy conferred by any of the specific provisions of this instrument is intended to be exclusive of any other remedy, and each and every remedy shall be cumulative and shall be in addition to every other remedy now or hereafter existing at law or in equity or by statute or otherwise. The election of any one or more remedy hereunder by the Norco Sportsmen’s Club shall not constitute any waiver of Norco Sportsmen’s Club right to pursue other available remedies. This instrument binds Undersigned and his/her executors, personal representatives, administrators, assignees, heirs and next of kin.

I also understand that if I bring guests to the ranges for shooting purposes that I am responsible for their activities and that they too MUST follow all of the rules and regulations set forth by the club. Any failure or non-compliance to these rules and regulations set forth could/will result in the loss of membership.

If/before I elect to utilize the NORCO club owned steel targets at the pistol/rifle ranges, I will read and abide by the rules and regulations, as stated in the steel target safety guide made available to me.
